



## Main Pre-school Sessions

We admit children to the main pre-school sessions at the start of the term in which they turn 2 years and 9 months.

Before your child starts with us, you will be offered two visit sessions which will give you an opportunity to meet the staff, some of the children, see how the sessions are run and discuss any issues or concerns you may have. You will receive a letter explaining the visits in more detail and giving you dates nearer the time.

**Note:** It is strongly encouraged that your child is potty trained for main pre-school sessions, but this is not mandatory.

We aim to give all children attending the main pre-school the opportunity to attend three morning sessions regardless of age. For the older children in the academic year before they join Primary School, we aim to give five sessions in total, but ask that you include afternoon sessions in your selection, either separately or to make full days.
