

## Safeguarding and Welfare Requirement: Child Protection

Providers must have and implement a policy, and procedures, to safeguard children.

### 1.2A Case Resolution Protocol

#### Policy statement

Our setting will work with children, parents and the community to ensure the rights and safety of children and to give them the very best start in life. The Wiltshire Safeguarding Children Board case resolution protocol sets out how to resolve professional disagreements relating to the safety of children, ensuring their needs remain at the heart of all we do as well as setting out how significant case disagreements will be managed. The protocol sets out responsibilities at organisational and individual level as well as behaviours that can promote resolutions. This replaces the Escalation Policy we previously had.

#### Procedures

We recognise that occasionally workers within one agency may feel the decision made by a worker from another agency on a child protection case may not be a safe decision.

If such a situation should arise we will follow the guidance set out in the Wiltshire Safeguarding Children Board Case Resolution Protocol (2018) - see attached document.

At Stage One, the manager is Rebecca Lanham.

At Stage Two, the senior manager is Nicky Lanham (our safeguarding lead).
